Plymouth Rock, The Revolutionary War, The Emancipation Proclamation, Juneteenth, and the Civil Rights Act of 1964 were all major milestones on that unfinished and arduous pursuit of liberty and justice for all. On June 19, 2022, - "Juneteenth" - The New Jersey Randonneurs region will honor that pursuit by hosting a Populaire that visits one of the many routes taken by enslaved Americans to achieve freedom. This 117km **Populaire** visits Underground Railroad sites in Woolwich, Marshalltown, Salem and Springtown / Othello NJ.

NJ Randonneurs encourages other RUSA members and RUSA regions to find routes in their area which reflect a similar recognition of that pursuit and join them in spirit for a Juneteenth "Freedom Ride" and celebrate the historic endurance,
