REGIONAL BREVET ADMINISTRATOR OPENINGS

The map of RUSA regions across the US has not always been as it is now. Unfortunately, a number of RUSA **regions** have gone inactive over the years. If you happen to live in or near a dormant RUSA region and you'd like to cut down on the long trips just to get to the start control of a brevet, consider becoming a RUSA Regional Brevet Administrator (RBA) and reviving one of these regions. For example, LA: New Orleans and OR: Northeastern are two regions that have shut down in the last year when a replacement RBA was not available. Other regions such as CA: Fresno, MO: St. Louis, AR: Little Rock and more are currently dormant, in want of an RBA.
