## RANDONNEURING MOMENTS: A VIEW OF A MONDIAL AWARDEE





8k600 brevets are 600k Audax Club Parisien (ACP) brevets with at least 8,000 meters (26,246 feet) of climbing. They are a requirement for earning the ACP 10,000 award.
