#### **PERMANENT PROGRAM FEE \$0**

The annual Permanent Program fee of \$10/year has been removed for 2026.

The annual permanent fee began in 2020, with the introduction of the new permanent program. This coincided with when we opened up riding during the pandemic.

Before that, there were permanent route owners, who could charge a fee per ride.

PERMANENT PROGRAM

#### **CLIMBING RESULTS DISPLAYED**

Beginning on January 1, 2026, your results will be expanded to include meters of climbing. The data collected in 2026 will be used to establish climbing award tiers, and then climbing awards will be given for 2026 and future years.

- RWGPS routes will be used to determine the climbing for any given brevet, permanent, or team event.
- The climbing recorded by your GPS device will not be the measure for the amount of your climbing.
- Team event climbing will be optional, based on your approved route.

With the 2026 climbing data collected, the Board will be able to determine realistic tiers for annual and lifetime climbing. For goal-setting in 2026, however, you might want to think about increments of 10,000 meters (32,808 feet).
