CLIMBING DATA IN RANONNEURS USA EVENTS

Starting on January 1st, 2026 we will track cumulative elevation gain in member results. This includes elevation gain from all existing sources of credited Randonneur USA (RUSA) distance, including permanents and all types of calendared events.

Here are the key points:

1. All processes will standardize on RideWithGPS routes, not ride tracks, for determining elevation gain.
2. When submitting permanent results, there will be additional inputs to indicate the direction ridden and optionally report a lower amount of climbing due to free-routing.
3. Team events will award credit for the amount of climbing. Teams will be responsible for drafting a RideWithGPS route corresponding to what was ridden, and submitting it to the organizer in a timely manner.


